APPLYING FOR A PERMIT IN CITIZENSERVE

As of April 1, 2023, all NEW construction projects MUST be submitted to Citizenserve.

- You will need to apply for a permit using our Citizenserve portal for all NEW construction projects. Construction projects that were submitted prior to April 1, 2023, will need to be issued through GOVmotus.
 - a. If you do not have a Citizenserve account, you will need to register for one.
 - b. Under "Online Services" please select "New Account Registration"
- 2. After logging in select "Apply for a Permit"
- 3. You will need to fill out the required information. All required fields are marked with a red line.
 - a. Application Type
 - i. Child Permit
 - ii. Fire and Building Safety Permit
 - iii. Post Permit Issuance Documents Review
 - iv. Preliminary Review
 - v. Space Use/Furniture Permit
 - b. Sub Type
 - c. Project Name
 - d. New or Existing Project
 - e. Address or Parcel #- NOTE the parcel number is the CAAN #
 - f. Was there a Preliminary Review for this project? Y/N
 - g. Work Description
 - h. Square Footage of Project Area
 - i. Funding Source
 - j. Signature
- 4. Adding additional contacts is not required but doing so allows the person to be able to do the following:
 - a. View permit information
 - b. Upload documents
 - c. Request inspections
- 5. All other information is NOT required but if you would like to include this information please do so.
- 6. Please attach all relevant files for the project being submitted.
- 7. After you have submitted to Citizenserve you should receive an email confirmation stating your application has been received.

- 8. Please ensure that 2 copies of the plans are delivered to the FABS Trailer.
 - a. The plan review will not begin until we have both the physical copies and electronic copy in Citizenserve.
